b.1959, based in Stockholm. Karin Lind is a visual artist and scenographer who, alongside her own practice, also works in the artist duo SIMKA with Simon Häggblom. SIMKA combines knowledge of visual arts, scenography, and landscape architecture. Central to their work is the exploration and creation of different spaces and places for human interaction.

In Karin Lind's art, sculpture, painting, and scenography constantly interact. Her practice oscillates between contrasting worlds in the lively stage setting and the quiet oasis of the studio. A deeply rooted interest in spatiality and the nature of materials is evident in all of Lind's works.

Since 1992, as a scenographer, she has worked on over 150 productions in theater, opera, and dance.
